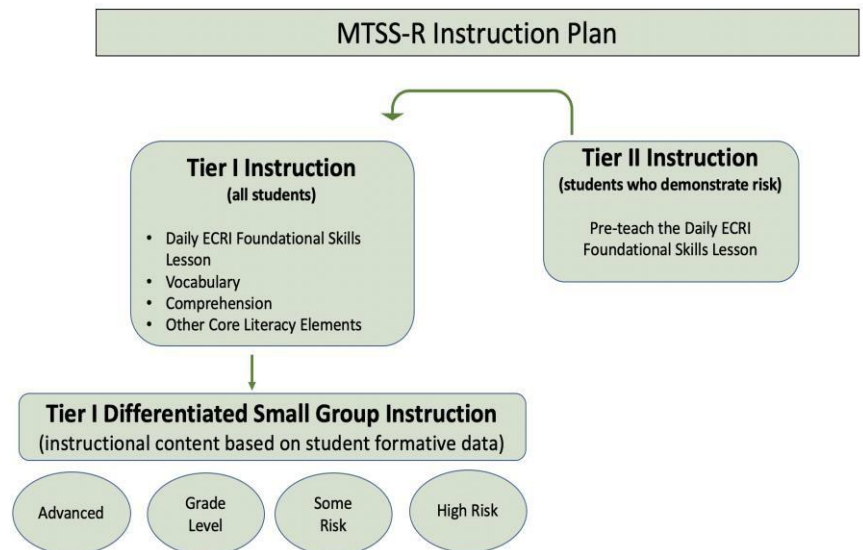


What is Enhanced Core Reading Instruction (ECRI)?

- Instructional routines and daily Tier I and Tier II lessons that supplement, overlay school's existing core reading program
- ECRI increases the explicitness and intensity of instruction
- ECRI increases cohesion between Tier I and Tier II:
 - Same scope and sequence of content
 - Same routines and language for introducing and practicing skills
 - Preteaching of content in Tier II to promote students' access to Tier I the following day



What does ECRI daily Tier I reading instruction look like?

- All students receive 90+ minutes of universal reading instruction with the core program (**Tier I**):
 - 30 minutes of whole group foundational skills instruction following the daily ECRI lesson
 - 30 minutes focuses on explicit vocabulary development, reading comprehension, and other literacy elements and using ECRI routines
 - 30 minutes for differentiated small group instruction, matched to student skills based on formative data

30 Minutes: Vocabulary and Comprehension	
30 Minutes: Differentiated Small Group	

What does ECRI daily Tier II reading instruction look like?

- Students who demonstrate risk on the basis of universal screening receive 30 minutes of small group intervention (**Tier II**) *daily*, in addition to Tier I:
 - Focuses on *pre-teaching* foundational skills portion of the Tier I daily lesson focused on phonemic awareness, phonics, and reading connected text
 - Uses the daily ECRI lesson aligned with the school's existing core reading program the day *prior* to its use in Tier I

Phonemic Awareness	2 m
Sound Spelling	2 m
Decodable Word Reading	5 m
Decodable Text Reading	12 m
Encoding Practice	5 m
Re-teaching	2 m
